

Pickpocketing! How to reduce the risk of theft?

Think what you really need when going out to a match.

The documents confirming your identity must be kept close to your body – you will be rarely using them.

Do not take more than 200 PLN. It will be enough to have a good dinner for one person and normally to pay a taxi, if you wish to take it in order to go back to the place of your stay.

Have some small bills – 10 and 20 PLN (in total about 50 PLN) within reach. The rest of the money keep in a separate place. When paying the bill do not show to everyone the content of your wallet.

If you take a camera, video-camera, tablet, smartphone, leave at the place you stay a note containing information enabling their identification. You can leave such information on your own e-mail address.

Always look what is going on around. Be reasonable when you meet new people, especially if they make the first contact.

In case of a theft, inform police as soon as possible. If you know who is the thief you can also inform the stewards or security guards (depending on the place where the theft took place).
